## Autozam AZ-1 - Little Known Mazda

Suzuki Motor Corporation began designing a midengine sports coupe in 1985, displaying the concept at the 1987 Tokyo Motor Show as the RS-3. Design work was stopped soon after, so that Suzuki could concentrate on a front-engine/rear-drive concept.

The RS-3 concept caught Mazda's interest, and Suzuki agreed to let them develop the car for production under Mazda's Autozam sub-brand. The design team which had created the Miata/MX-5 took over and created three separate concepts. Only one of the three had gull-wing doors and Mazda's top brass chose it. Developing the AZ-1 for production was challenging, and took three years with the car



debuting in 1992. During that period, Japan's economy underwent a recession. As a result, fewer than 4,400 AZ-1s were built before production ended in 1994.

Specs: Mid-engine, rear drive. Turbocharged 63 hp, 3 cyl, 657 cc engine. 5-speed manual. \$12,400 USD
